Background Information

Sequestosome-1 (SQSTM1) is an autophagy receptor that binds ubiquitin and regulates activation of the nuclear factor kappa-B (NF- κ B) signaling pathway. SQSTM1 functions as a scaffolding/adaptor protein with TNF receptor-associated factor 6 (TRAF6). Mutations in SQSTM1 are also observed in familial ALS cases associated with aberrant TDP-43 inclusions and additionally mutations in SQSTM1 may result in Paget disease of bone. SQSTM1 may also be involved in cell differentiation, apoptosis, immune response and regulation of K⁺ channels.
